National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute (NABI), Mohali, is an autonomous R&D Institute under Department of Biotechnology, Government of India. The institute is meant to strengthen research at the interface of agriculture biotechnology, food processing and nutritional sciences. Research Positions in Projects

Candidates having experience in the analysis of genomic sequencing, analysis & SNPs will be preferred.

SR. RESEARCH FELLOW: Should have done M.Sc. in plant or life sciences, Biotechnology, biochemistry and related subjects with minimum 60% marks and should have two years post-M.Sc. research experience with at least one research paper published in reputed journals in molecular biology.

Stipend, Age and general conditions: The above mentioned positions are completely temporary and are co-terminus with the project subject to a maximum of 03 years. The initial appointment will be for a period of one year, but can be curtailed or extended based on the performance at discretion of the Competent Authority.

Based on the qualifications, experience & publications record, the stipend for RA will be fixed at Rs.16000/- to Rs.18000/- per month as in case of CSIR. The upper age limit for award of RA shall be 35 years. For SRF, the upper age limit for SRF shall be 32 years and the stipend will be Rs.14000/- pm. Both RA & SRF will be given a contingent research grant of Rs.20000/- per annum. The age limit is relaxable up to 5 years in the case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes/tribes, women, physically handicapped and OBC applicants.
