NOTICE INVITING TENDER

- 1. Sealed tenders are invited on behalf of the Executive Director, NABI from agencies who have executed similar works with PWD's State/MES/HUDA/PUDA/CHB/CPWD contactors or other reputed private agency who have already executed such execution works of digging, supply and installation cum commissioning of bore wells.
 - 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 4.97 lakhs**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
 - 1.2 Tenders will be issued to eligible C.P.W.D/PWD of states / MES/Rly / BSNL / M.C. / Local Bodies /Govt. PSUs/private contractors provided they produce definite proof from the appropriate authority which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ISSUE OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Pre-qualification condition: Having satisfactorily completed work as given below in the last 7 years:-

- i) Three similar works, each of value not less than 40% of the estimated cost put to tender or
- ii) Two similar works, each of value not less than 60% of the estimated cost or
- iii) One similar work of value not less than 80% of the estimated cost.

For the purpose of this clause 'Similar work' means the work of supply and installation of bore well by using the specifications resembling with those specified in Schedule-A

- 2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed tender format prescribed in Schedule-F on Rs 50 Non- Judicial Stamp Paper. Tenderers shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 1 month from the 7th day after the date of written orders to commence the work or from the first date of handing over of the site. Whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender document.
- 4. Tenders document consisting of plant, specifications, the schedule of quantities of the various classes of work to be done and the set of terms and conditions of contract be complied with by the contractor can be seen in the office of the SPO NABI during working hours except on Saturdays, Sundays/ Public Holidays.
- 5. Tender document will be issued from the office of the SPO, NABI during the hours specified above on payment of Rs.500 (non-refundable) in cash at NABI Office/download it from website www.nabi.res.in and submit DD of Rs. 500 in the name of National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute payable at Mohali.

- 6. Tenders, which should always be placed in sealed envelope, with the name of work and due date written on the envelope, will be received by the SPO up to 3.00 PM. onand will be opened by him or his authorized representative in his office on the same day at 03.30 PM.
- 7. The tender shall be accompanied by earnest money of Rs 10,000 in a shape of Demand Draft / Deposit at Call receipt of a Scheduled Bank issued in favour of the National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute (NABI), payable at Mohali. No interest will be paid on the earnest money.
 - 7.2 The tender and the earnest money shall be placed in separate sealed envelopes each marked "**Tender**" and "**Earnest Money**" respectively. Both the envelops shall be submitted together in another sealed envelope. The envelop marked "Tender" of only those tenderers shall be opened, whose earnest money placed
- 8. The description of the work is as follows:-

Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub soil (so far as is practicable) the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own costs all materials, tools and plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant etc. will be issued to him by the Institute and any other local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

- 9. The competent authority on behalf of the Executive Director, NABI does not bind him to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to him the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without the assignment of a reason. All tenders, in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
- 10. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

- 11. The competent authority on behalf of the Executive Director, NABI reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 12. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the Institute if his near relative is an officer in any capacity between the Administrative Officer and work awarding authority (responsible for award and execution of contracts). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relative to any Group A & B officer in the Institute. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Institute / debarring for further tendering in the Institute for at least 5 years.
- 13. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening of tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Institute shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid.
- 14. This Notice inviting tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful tenderer/contractor, on an acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority, shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of award sign the agreement consisting of:
 - a) The notice inviting tender, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming the tender as issued at the time of invitation of tender and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - b) Agreement Format provided in this document.
- 15. No price preference to any corporate society/Registered society, Govt. Public Sector undertakings / bodies shall be given and tenders shall be exclusively dealt with on merit.
- 16. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of the Apprentices Act 1961, minimum wages Act 1948, Workmen's compensation Act 1923, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition Act 1970), Payment of Wages Act 1938, Employer's Liability Act 1938, Maternity Benefits Act 1961 and the Industrial Disputes Act 1947 as applicable and the rules and regulations issued there under and by the local Administration / Authorities from time to time as well all provisions of law applicable to workmen. Failure to do so shall amount to breach of the contract and the Administrative Officer may at his discretion terminate the contract. The Contractor shall also be liable for any pecuniary liability arising on account of violation by him of any of the said Acts and shall, indemnify the Institute on that account. Institute will not be liable for any act or omission on the part of the contractor in so far as any violation of any of the aforementioned acts.
- 17. Each tenderer shall submit only one tender; either by him or as partners in a joint venture. A tenderer who submits or participates in more than one tender will be disqualified.
- 18. Unless otherwise stated, the contract shall be for the whole work as described in the "Schedule of items of Works" and the drawings. The contractor shall be bound to complete the

whole work as described in the schedule of items of works and the drawings, including additional items, if any, as per drawings and notifications. The issuance of certificate of completion as issued by Administrative Officer shall be mandatory and will be conclusive proof of completion of work.

- 19. Interpretations, corrections and changes to the Tenders Documents shall be made by Addendum, if required.
- 20. Each Tenderer shall ascertain prior to submitting his Tender that he has received all Addenda Issued and he shall so acknowledge their receipt in his Tender.
- 21. Following documents shall accompany the tender:
 - i) Demand draft/Deposit at call receipt from a Scheduled Bank towards earnest Money & Tender Fee in favour of National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute payable at Mohali.
 - ii) Income Tax Certificate for 2 yrs.
 - iii) Completion certificate clearly showing the eligibility of contractor as per prequalification criteria.
- 22. The Provisions in the Tender documents shall govern over the contents of the above paragraphs if in contradiction or variation.

<u>SCHEDULE 'A'</u>

DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

- Type of drilling method—As per nature of formation below the ground the best suitable drilling methods are either Direct or Reverse Rotary method with drilling diameter of min. 22"/18".
- As per presence of good quality of water or aquifer zone, slots have to be made in PVC pipes to accommodate water at all times. Pipes shall be properly connected by sockets with liquid solvents. Pipe shall be connected at top by MS clamp set.
- The annular space between wall of the bore & casing assembly should be filled by well sorted pea gravel of size 1-3 mm. Additional gravel to be filled after completion of gravel.
- The development of bore well to be recommended/done by high capacity air compressor (Min 300 cfm/150 psi as per IS -2800 Part II).
- The bore well shall be sealed at top up to height of 1' with cement concrete 1:2:4 to avoid percolation of surface run-off in the bore well.
- The bore well should be plugged to bottom by bail plug & top by well cap.
- The pump set should be of approved make, conforming to IS specifications suitable for 415 volts, 3 phase, 50 cycles AC supply having delivery outlet of 3" and suitable for connecting outer MS pipe of at least 5' at height of approx.. 4'.
- The delivery pipe shall be connected at top by clamp sets suitable for outer dia pipe.
- The pump set shall be connected for power supply by PVC insulated copper water proof cable 3C 6mm size.
- Contracting Agency to provide the strata data in log charts showing the depth of filtered layers etc after completion of work.

Terms & Conditions:-

- 1. Rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes.
- 2. Conditional/Incomplete tenders shall be rejected.
- 3. The agency shall provide Bank Guarantee of 5% within 15 days of award of work valid up to one year.
- 4. Advance of maximum 75% of award value may be considered against supply of material.
- 5. Warranty up to 1 year from the date of commissioning of system, if any defect is found in that period contractor to repair the same without any additional expenditure including excavation and lowering of pump etc.
- 6. Statutory tax deductions as per rules of Govt. shall be deducted.
- 7. In case of Delay in completion of work within stipulated period, penalty of 1% per week and maximum of 5% shall be levied.
- 8. External electrical supply cabling and water requirement shall be provided by NABI from existing bore well. However, contractor to check the quantity of water available in existing bore well, if not sufficient, contractor to make his own arrangements.
- 9. Any digging of earth for fixing of rotary machine or for storage of water shall be made good after completion of work.
